After three and a half months of intense rehearsal with a cast of 35 I think I can safely say NO to the first two questions and undoubtedly YES to the last two. Watching the cast grow and bloom from their first read-through to their very last dress rehearsal has been an absolute privilege. Helping and guiding them through the intricacies and depths of their characters has been an eye-opening experience and one that I will never forget. For me, being able to provide the youth of this community with the opportunity to work together in a team environment, that is not competitive, and to explore the hidden talents within them. I hope that this production has given the cast the confidence and desire to explore and continue their theatre experiences. I have had the time of my life during this show and I would like to thank everyone involved for their encouragement and support.

## Synopsis

Jesus Christ Superstar focuses on the last seven days of Christ's life, his betrayal and crucifixion, seen from the point of view of Judas.
